For the 2010-2011 school year applications will be accepted for 5th grade students and a limited number of 6th grade students. Acceptance may be based on attendance zone criteria as defined by our charter.* Currently, students from our tier 2 area may also be limited by availability of space on the buses to that area. New students *must* plan to attend our summer school in June 2010.

*“The attendance zone will be comprised of three tiers. First priority will be given to children of families living in Tier 1, the Buford Highway Corridor, which is defined by Interstate 85 as the southeast boundary, the Fulton-DeKalb County line as the west boundary, the Gwinnett-DeKalb County line as the north boundary, and a line one-half mile to the northwest and parallel to Peachtree Street/Peachtree Industrial Boulevard as the northwest boundary. If space allows, priority will be given to children of families living in Tier 2, which is the Clarkston, Stone Mountain, Lithonia area defined by the following zip codes – 30021, 30032, 30034, 30035, 30083, and 30088. Remaining spaces may be filled with children of families living in the DeKalb County School District but not within Tiers 1 or 2.” (*DeKalb PATH Academy Charter*)

This application must be sent to PATH (by mail, fax, or in person) by **April 10, 2010**. If there are more applications than available space, a lottery will be held.
